

Fr. Dr. Jose Kalapura, SJ, the current (second term) Director of Xavier Institute of Social Research, initiated four series of publications at XISR: 1) Bihar Subaltern Study Series (based on field research), 2) Arrupe Memorial Lecture Series 3) Bihar Human Rights Documentary Study Series and 4) Seminar-based publications. XISR has 39 publications now.

Dr. Kalapura did his MA in History from Pune University, M. Phil and Ph. D. in History from New Delhi's Jawaharlal Nehru University. He has co-authored/edited 18 books, and has 86 research papers of which 70 papers have been published in edited books, encyclopedias and journals. He has presented papers in national seminars and international seminars in India and abroad.

He is a life member of the Indian History Congress and member of the Church History Association of India. He was awarded Dr. I. G. Khan Memorial Best Paper in Science History by the Indian History Congress, in 2006 and in 2007. Earlier in 2002 he received an international award from Berkeley University, USA, for designing a course on Environment and Religions for Patna Women's College of Patna University.

He also designed a Certificate Course on Christianity for Nalanda Open University, Patna and wrote three text books for the same course.

He taught History at St. Xavier's College, Patna and Christian History for several years at four Theology Institutes in India. He is currently the Executive Editor of the *Indian Church History Review*, an academic journal on Christianity in India.
